Objectives:

- To provide a forum for Analytical and Research Leads to discuss and exchange information on data analytical and reporting issues approaches and learning
- To foster a learning community where Analytical and Research Leads can share challenges and examples of best practice
- To enable Analytical and Research Leads to provide feedback to UCD on both data analysis and research issues in order to align International NFP practice and learning with the wider NFP research and strategic development of the programme.

As a result:

- All countries are able to use the expertise of others within the group to inform and progress their own work
- The approaches to the work are debated and innovative solutions are found for common challenges
- Opportunities for testing innovations collaboratively between countries are explored
- NFP materials and resources are shared, so increasing efficiency and reducing costs
- Areas for further action across all countries are identified and an International approach to change is established

Scope:

- Data analytical practices, including data aggregation, cleaning, completeness, analytical processes and methods
- Interpretation of findings from data reports
- Interrogation of particular data sets or screening tools
- Use of data reports through the system (team to country)
- Sharing findings of data analyses between countries
- Making recommendations regarding global changes to data sets or research priorities

Membership:

- One or two data/analytical lead(s)from each country
- International team members Ann Rowe and Gail Radford- Trotter, who will coordinate and chair the group

• Expert Advisor and member - Dr David Olds

Meetings:

- Timing that aims to suit all international time zones as much as possible
- 1 hour quarterly via Zoom, and as needed
- The agenda will be sent in advance of the meeting
