### 4. Quality Improvement Project updates Deirdre/All

- → Deirdre created an outline/draft of the paper -- Quality Improvement Project How does the Family Nurse support clients who experience a child being removed from her care?
- We sent out the brief questionnaire and a couple weeks ago, Anna asked for Ed leads to send names of supervisors to be interviewed...those are currently being scheduled.
- More suitable to be an ongoing project versus a submission to the CAN Special Issue.
- Some further thoughts that came from the chat:
- Belinda (Australia):
  - In Australia we would of had to manually count the data. It has prompted us though to collect this valuable data and it will be added into our data set system for staff to collect ongoing fro m 2025.
- Lesley (Scotland): Could this be suitable for the CAN journal at a later date, and not specifically the special issue? It sounds like it would be hard to understand the system in the first place.
   Without that it's pretty challenging to undertake a QI project.
- Lindsay (Ontario): I echo others and would add that we in Ontario have been able to support clients when a child has been removed since we started, however we just started to be able to

report indicators of this as of last year. So we have lots to share in terms of practice but data isn't readily accessible yet.

- Bottom line: we will continue to pursue this project but with a different plan/timeline. Will not be submitting anything for the Special Issue, but is a topic worth pursuing further.

- Lesley (Scotland): we use Kirkpatrick model of evaluation − 4 levels; an 'end of education' evaluation for educators; Educator Bag: paper bag → put thoughts/comments on post itnotes to come back to; look at data locally and nationally and see what is emerging; educators have observation over facilitation of learning twice a year
- Lindsay (Ontario) and Catherine (Northern Ireland) echoing how helpful Scotland's education team is when seeking ideas/feedback they are a great resource!
- Nicole (England): How do countries or provinces update facilitators (regarding materials)?
