David & Deirdre: Strategy discussion</p>	<p>Different experiences of value that come from strategic lead conversations.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Differences in government/priorities → situations are always changing. There are different mandates at government level for those in strategic lead positions – competing priorities. - Positioning program within policy or government apparatus can be difficult. <p>Importance of evidence-based policymaking.</p> <p>Collective job – help public and policymakers appreciate investing in programs that are supported by evidence.</p> <p>Where does program fit in broader array of government programs (across all societies)?</p> <p>David – write a brief/position on evidence-based policy/practice in early years and share it with everyone—would you feel it helpful to adapt to your governments? → could be a draft that we bring forward in the next meeting.</p> <p>“Re-energize” governments about importance of program</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Lindsay shared that in Ontario, the NFP was recognized in the 2023 Chief Medical Officer of Health's report: chrome-extension://efaidnbnmnnibpcajpcglclefindmkaj/https://www.ontario.ca/files/2024-04/moh-cmoh-annual-report-2023-en-2024-04-02.pdf page 31
